You will be based in central London with a national brief. You will be responsible for the development and implementation of all aspects of the charity's fundraising and revenue generation activities, including:

- Ensure the charity is making the most of its assets, especially in developing new corporate partners
- Develop SportsAid's major donor programme
- Lead and manage SportsAid's fundraising and partnerships team

You will have significant fundraising experience (at least five years) with a strong track-record and demonstrable success in securing new revenue on a large scale and in developing long-term partnerships, especially with the corporate sector. Leading the team, you will also be confident implementing and developing fundraising strategy, working with other internal and external stakeholders to deliver income generation growth and will have the ability to monitor and report progress. You will have excellent organisational and presentation skills and will be an effective communicator with lots of enthusiasm. Sound IT skills and a working-knowledge of database management and Excel will be essential.
